




Before you were born, every day monsters would appear somewhere in Japan. That was a big problem.




As you already know, Japan is a country where there are many monsters.

So very intelligent scientists gathered to study the monsters.





We built it!




So the scientists all worked together to build a "Monster Roar Translation Machine."

Businessmen who are off on weekends become Weekend Men and have to talk with the monsters. So you see, they're not fighting the monsters.


Ahem... Uh... Well...

The people who become Weekend Man are selected on a shift system.





There is a "Monster Roar Translation Machine" in the Weekend Man mask so that's how they can talk with the monsters.




And this is why Weekend Man looks slightly different every time.

So that means you might become Weekend Man, too, Dad.








