

Tottori Port lies in the east of Tottori Prefecture, which is situated almost in the middle of the Sea of Japan side of western Japan. The port has been developing as a hub of sea routes connecting the Korean Peninsula, Izumo, Oki, and Tajima Island.

Attractive sightseeing spots, such as the "Tottori Sand Dunes", "The Sand Museum", and "Uradome Coast",

are situated near the port. Furthermore, you can visit and enjoy "The Nageiredo Hall of Sanbutsu-ji Temple", a national treasure built on a steep mountain cliff, and "Akagawara-Shirakabe Dozogun Storehouses", the old buildings and streets remaining in Kurayoshi City, both situated in the middle of Tottori Prefecture.
